## Hawkeye Presidential Tower Shoot

Hawkeye’s tower shoots are a favorite among our guests who enjoy the fast-paced shooting, comradery, and relaxed shaded nature of the shoot. Shooters rotate through numbered stations while pheasants are released at 15 second intervals, weaving through the tall pines creating a very fun and challenging experience.

These tower shoots are great for groups from 10 to 24 shooters as they allow for lots of interaction between members of the group, require minimal walking, and can be enjoyed safely without full hunting attire. We just finished revamping our pheasant tower field by removing many of the leafy trees and adjusting each station to provide a more clear line of sight for shooters. This will ensure more safe shots at each bird from multiple stations. Call us today to add a tower shoot to your next Hawkeye Experience.
